Missing Vacuum Cap

How to inspect for a Missing Vacuum Cap:

- 1. Approach the RIGHT side of the motorcycle
- 2. Using a light, look under the tank at the Air Cleaner location, on top of the Throttle Body
- 3. It is hard to see and sets back in between the cylinders, on top of the Throttle Body
- 4. There is a ¼" steel vacuum tube
- 5. This steel vacuum tube should have a rubber cap on it
- 6. Verify the rubber cap is in place
- **7.** If the rubber cap is missing, it must be replaced

Note: Refer to "Map - Reloading Your Base Map" if the cap is found to be missing.

NOTE: Auto parts stores will have rubber vacuum caps OR you can use a short piece of vacuum hose with a small bolt in the end (acting as a plug). The "hose and bolt" arrangement is actually more secure than the rubber caps. A little ugly but does not show.
